

IMPORTANT MERGER UPDATE

Dear Valued Members,

As we approach our merger date of January 21, 2017, I wanted to take a quick moment to update you on a couple of changes that may impact you.

First, our 66th Street branch will now **close at 2pm on Friday, January 20th**. By closing early on the 20th, this will allow us a few extra hours to complete the data merge.

Second, your Polk County Schools Employees Credit Union **debit cards will be shut off at noon on the 20th, however, your credit cards will continue to work until 5pm**. You should receive your new debit and credit cards by January 13th. You may activate these cards right away, however, you will not be able to use them until late afternoon or early evening on the 21st. Please watch the merger page on our website and Facebook page on the 21st for when these cards will be active.

Lastly, your **home banking and Bill Pay will shut off at the close of business on January 18th**. If you have any reoccurring transactions scheduled in your current bill pay, those will not be sent out starting on 1/19/2017.

We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you! We are looking forward to serving you as members develop deeper relationships with you as we grow together for years to come.
